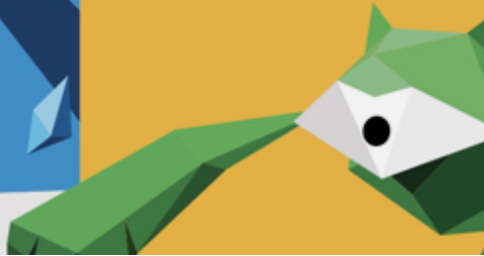

WHAT DO YOU DO IF YOU SEE SOMEONE BEING BULLIED ONLINE?

- Take time out before getting involved and don't share or like negative comments.
- Ask an adult, friend or charity such as ChildLine that you can trust for advice.
- Use the report button on the social media platform it's happening on.
- Give the person being bullied a supportive message to let them know they are not alone.
- Encourage them to talk to someone they can trust.
- Give the person being bullied a positive distraction from the situation.

CRICKLADE MANOR INTERNET SAFETY RULES

I will be internet :

SHARP

by using my first name or initials and not full names for online quizzes and games suggested by my teacher

by not giving my home address or telephone number to anyone over the internet

ALERT

by being suspicious of unexpected contacts and messages and only download material approved by my teacher

by not arranging to meet anyone contacted over the internet

by not searching for inappropriate material on the Internet

SECURE

by using a secure password with upper case, numbers and special characters and logging out of devices after I have used them

by only using the internet for activities and work assigned by a teacher

by only download apps / material that have been approved by my teacher or parent.

by respecting the privacy of others and not publish their names, addresses, phone numbers or photographs

KIND

by only sending polite and positive messages online. I will not send unsuitable messages or pictures

by only making contact through chat with friends, classmates and teachers at CMP and not delete other pupils from group chats without their permission.

BRAVE

by reporting any unpleasant material or messages sent to me. I understand that this will help to protect other pupils and myself

Pupils who are unable to follow these rules will have their access to Cricklade Manor Internet restricted. (This will affect their ability to access content and therefore their ability to learn)
