Funding periods are 1 Sept – 31 Dec; 1 Jan – 31 Mar; 1 Apr – 31 Aug

Funding is applied for the period following a child's 3rd birthday and finishes at the end of the period in which they turn 5

All year-round provision – a maximum of 30 funded hours is claimed for 38 weeks for eligible children in Nursery

Term time provision – a maximum of 30 funded hours is claimed for 33 weeks for eligible children in Nursery
