Funding

Please note

The above Nursery fees exclude the Early Years Free Entitlement funding

Funding periods are 1 Sept – 31 Dec; 1 Jan – 31 Mar; 1 Apr – 31 Aug

Funding is applied to invoices for eligible children

Nursery (all year-round) – a maximum of 30 funded hours is claimed for 38 weeks for eligible children

Nursery (term time) – a maximum of 30 funded hours is claimed for 33 weeks for eligible children

Reception – a maximum of 15 funded hours is claimed for 33 weeks for eligible children
